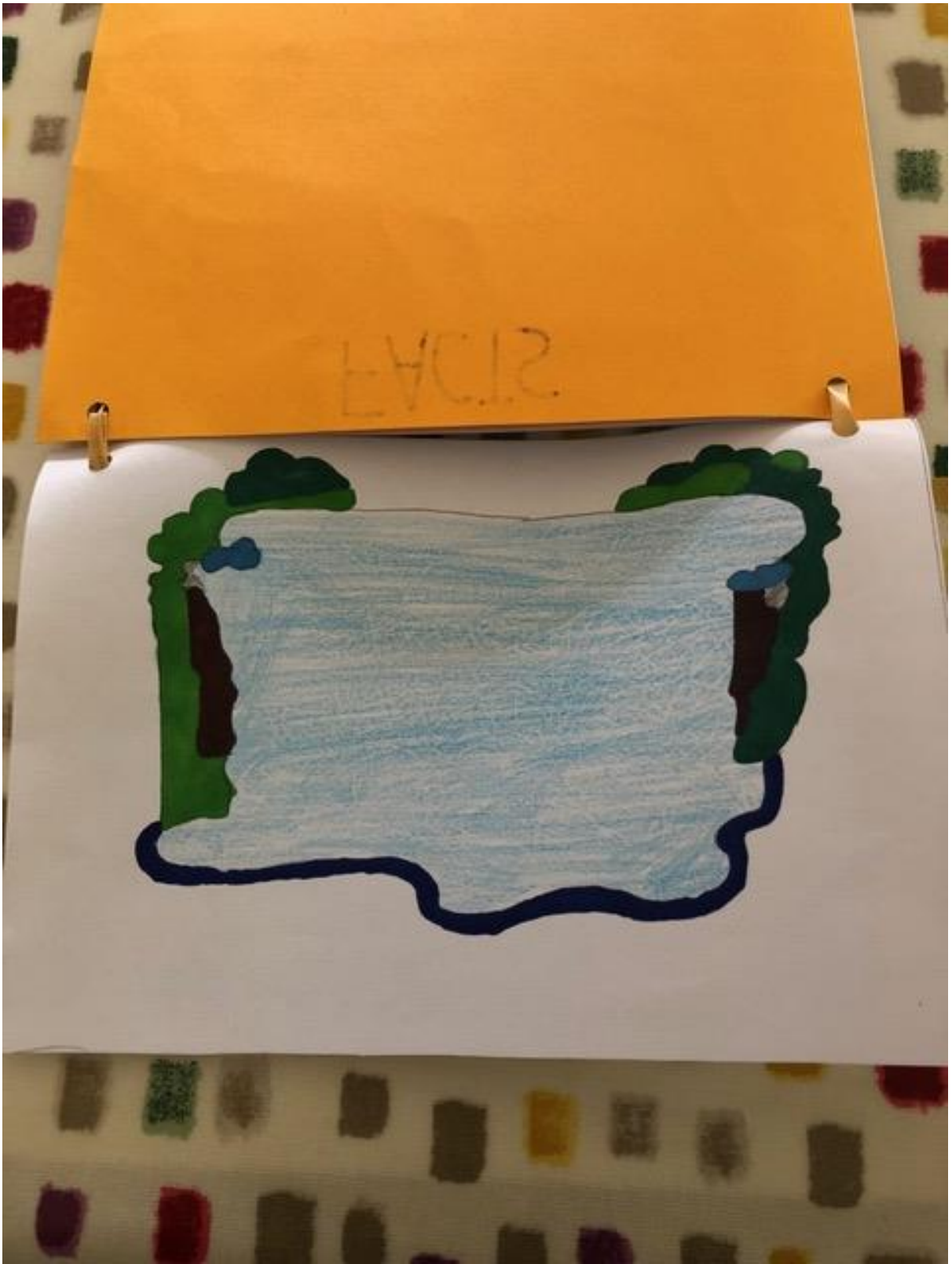


Niagara Falls
